Azad Shiksha Kendra (ASK), Jaunpur, Uttar Pradesh was registered as a Trust in 2004. It is a non-political and non-profit organization organization engaged in socio-economic up-liftment and welfare of poor and deprived sections of the society with a explicit focus on most backward and minority dominated regions of the state. The organization draws its ideological strength from Gandhian ideals and secular and democratic values. It it has brought together a dedicated group of professionals like doctors, lawyers and social workers to address the developmental issues emerging in focal regions. Besides, there is a team of dedicated workers guided by voluntary spirit and social commitment.

As an organization we are essentially concerned with the elimination of child labour, protection of women, promotion of education and health care, rural livelihood enhancement and right to information etc. And the programmes are largely focused on Muslim, Dalit and Musahar communities in Azamgarh and Saharanpur districts, besides, of course, Jaunpur.

Right since the inception, the organization has undertaken large number of projects/programmes which enabled lakhs of people from partner communities to have better access to health care, nutrition, literacy and education, livelihood etc. The main thrust has been on women empowerment and child development. Strategically, we maintain better coordination and rapport with government agencioes/departments, PRIs, local NGOs/CBOs and women led organizations at various levels.

Subjects that the organization has worked on and currently engaged in

There have essentially been three permanent issues on the agenda of the organization right since the beginning. These encompass Primary Education, *Madarsah* Education and Child Rights, involving whole range of education and health rights of children.

The following activities have been done this year under the leadership of Managing Trustee Mr Nisar Ahmad Khan:

Local Capacity for Peace (LCP): In a meeting with the youth, their action plan for the past month was discussed and writing a daily diary was discussed. Two youths will go to the youth conference whose Voter ID and Aadhar are the same. It was told that whoever has an Android phone, should exchange the information and the one whose guardian has the phone, should check from the guardian once in 24 hours whether any message has been received and also inform his nearby friend who does not have an Android phone. It was decided that on 14th April Ambedkar Jayanti, on 29th April an Iftar party and on 30th April Eid Milan celebration will be held.



Eid Milan Programme- On 30th April 2023, Eid Milan program was organized in Babu Rameshwar Prasad Hall Ras Mandal Jaunpur with aim to maintain mutual harmony, social harmony and brotherhood. In the program, the youth of Khetasarai, Machhali Shahar, along with poets of district and other districts as well as representatives of other institutions and workers of Azad Shiksha Kendra expressed their ideas and recited their poetry and discussion was held on social harmony and health related issues in which 70 people participated.



LCP Youth Meeting- On 14.05.2023, Azad Shiksha Kendra held a follow up meeting with Machhali Shahar and Khetasarai Youth at Rameshwar Shishu Vihar Ras Mandal Jaunpur. Mr. Nisar while discussion said that any work should be done with a standard and equality should be maintained and there

should no discrimination on the basis of caste. All religions, rich and poor should be treated equal.

Environment Day- On 5th June, by celebrating Environment Day, a plan was made to distribute pamphlets and take out a rally and it was asked to work on water conservation. There is a need to



work on how the process of making an organization is carried out. It was told to do MSW for social work, along with that, it was asked to work by making an action plan. Like, applying mehendi in the summer camp, teaching computers, telling stories and teaching etc. The meeting was concluded by discussing these topics.

Orientation Workshop- On 27th, 28th May 2023, Azad Shiksha Kendra organized a two-day residential orientation workshop on shared heritage with the participants from Khetasarai and Machhali



Shahar at Rameshwar Shishu Vihar Ras Mandal Jaunpur, in which some participants took training on the concept formation process of shared heritage, negative, positive shared heritage and various forms of shared heritage. The workshop was organized after feeling the need for a workshop to remind people of the issues that they had forgotten in preparation for the TOT to be held in Delhi. trainers of this workshop were Nisar Ahmed Khan, Jyotika Srivastava and Prabha Devi.

On 03.06.2023, in village Sheikhupur Mansoor Ali, the concept of shared heritage was discussed with the women and they were told what is shared

heritage and how it is formed. The women enthusiastically told that we do farming, marriages in common, we go to each other's house to perform Sohar on the birth of a child and sing and dance songs in marriages and with each other's help, we do the making of mandap, cooking food, giving dowry items in common and we

have inherited this tradition. The women were informed about the fair of Ghazi Miya, in Sarai Khwaja and other places. In this way, after telling what is shared heritage, the women sang wedding songs and then the program concluded.

Meeting of Key Persons- On 04.06.2023, a meeting was held with 8 members of Key persons at Azad Shiksha Kendra Rameshwar Shishu Vihar Ras Mandal Jaunpur as it was held with the Panchayat members last month. This time a meeting was held with



health worker, in which the concept of shared heritage and group organization formation was discussed. Two Asha workers cooperated to maintain connectivity in the city, in which discussion on ration distribution in lockdown, discussion on active women, pregnant women, breastfeeding, radio, FM, from which all rickshaw, four-wheeler people will listen, information group work was done by meeting on shared heritage. Nisar Sir informed that now a three-day training will be held with 36 Asha workers. All Asha workers will bring two Asha Didi with them, the meeting concluded with this type of discussion.

Youth Camp- A two-day youth camp was organized with the youth of Machhlisahr and Kheta sarai on 22nd, 23rd June 2023 in Hindi Bhavan Jaunpur, in which gender, discrimination, how to maintain peace and harmony in the village along



with Shared heritage, temporary unity of peace, organization etc were discussed. Who am I, who is a human, in this way, along with talking on many issues, the two-day youth camp was concluded.

On 15.07.2023, under the Shared Heritage Program, 60 out of 100 youths from a total of 9



villages were present at Azad Shiksha Kendra Mohalla Takiya. They discussed what is shared heritage, how is it formed, positive shared heritage and negative shared heritage. The youth had visited the historical site Kishauchha Sharif and they were given information about it that people of all castes and religions were seen together there. Thus, our folk songs, Sohar, wedding songs, food, clothing, lifestyle, dialect etc. is shared heritage.

On 21.07.2023, a meeting was held on shared heritage in Sondhi village, in which it is told that songs, music are also shared heritage. While discussing this, women sang



Kajri songs. After joining Azad Shiksha Kendra, it came out that what we have inherited and what we have been doing is shared heritage. After joining, it was known that going to each other's house and singing songs on various occasions is shared heritage. But how our shared heritage is getting extinct. We are not able to see it, it needs to be seen and saved. Shrishi Talab is a shared heritage. This time it was decided that Kajri festival will be celebrated there.



On 23.07.2023, a program was organized on shared heritage with 41 youth in Takiya Mohalla, in which the youth were asked to

tell what happened in the last meeting. Everyone said that in the present time there is a lot of tension and conflict regarding religion and inflation. After that, kitchen garden, preparing organic manure, growing organic vegetables, marriages with mutual transactions, Kajgaon fair in Jaunpur, Qawwali etc. are shared heritage. After this discussion, the youth were divided into four groups and had to write the shared heritage of their area. All the four groups wrote and presented it and then it was concluded.



Youth meeting- On 30.07.2023 a meeting was held on shared heritage which started with a prayer, O Data, give us so much power, after the prayer everyone was told what is shared heritage, the children told that in the last meeting also the concept of shared heritage was told, a page was given to write about meaning of shared heritage, the story of Daastan Goi, Alha Rudal was narrated, after this the fair of Ghazi Mian was discussed.

Old Seeds like Kakun, Sawa, Bajra, Kodo, Ragi, Sorghum, Maize etc and Musical instruments, Dhol, Majira, Flute, Harmonia, Tabla, Dhapli, Sarangi, Bell, Sankhya, Ghughru, Nagada, Damru etc., Rope from Sunai, Rope of Petuwa etc. are told to be part of our shared heritage. It takes many years to form a shared heritage. All the tools of farming are our shared heritage. After this type of discussion, everyone was given a task to find out-

When did Sondhi's Ramleela start?

When was Khetasarai's police station established?

Names of Police station officers who have been posted since the police station was established?

After forming a group comprising Pratima, Sweety, Govinda, Pratik, Aditya, Kushagri, Aradhya, Gaurav, Shivangi that tasked to go to the police station. After getting the task, the meeting was concluded.

15th August Program- Flag hoisting was done on the occasion of Independence Day program with 50 men, 21 women and children in which participants from private school, inter college, primary school, madrasa children, government school teachers, Talim Center, girls' employment center, girls and women ward, councilor institution and Azad Shiksha Kendra friends were present. In the program welcome song, poem, drama etc.



were presented by the children and it was narrated to them about heroes who have sacrificed their lives to make the country independent. It was discussed that peace and harmony will come by ending the evils spread in the country and by working together, not on religious basis, and also discussion was held

on education and our constitutional rights and ban on child marriage, in order to make everyone educated, organized and strong. A plan was made that we will prepare girls and women one month before any program, and how to prepare people of other communities to pursue education and getting employment etc. The meeting was concluded by discussing these issues.



Youth Adda- On 03.09.2023, a youth meeting was held with 22 participants at Azad Shiksha Kendra Khetasari Takiya Mohalla. In the beginning, the song-

Apne liye jiye to kya jiye- Tu ji ae dil jamane ke liye, was sung.

After that, registration was done, shared heritage was discussed and a review was taken. The youth were told that our farming, our tools, songs, fairs, all are our shared heritage. It was told when the police station was built, when did Sondhi's Ramlila start, this task was given, the youth told. Nisar Khan discussed with the youth about taking out a rally and made a plan as to what strategy would be done.

Youth meeting- On 10.09.2023, a meeting was held with the youth/children on shared heritage and a content on communalism and



terrorism was given to all the children to read, which depicted Indian society, Indian culture, plurality, as India is a country that encompasses diversity. The British rulers created the differences between the Hindu and Muslim elites and

they adopted the policy of divide and rule. Muslim communal politics, reasons for communalism, nation theory, fatwa politics, information about the demolition of Babri Masjid, Babur's will, Guru Granth Sahib etc. along with Hindu and Muslim religions were discussed to celebrate festivals together. Nisar Ahmed Khan explained to the children that we should take care of the environment in which we live, our poets are also our shared heritage, they have also always mentioned living together. People around us are the ones who help us in our bad days. We should not discriminate on the basis of gender, caste, religion or race. We should not create tension or conflict and maintain brotherhood amongst ourselves. We should stay away from fundamentalists. Thus, after the discussion in the meeting, the meeting was concluded by serving refreshments to all.



Picture Exhibition- Like last year, this year also Gandhi Picture Exhibition was organized in Azad

Shiksha Kendra office on 2nd of October as a fortnight event from 2 October 2023 to 8 October 2023, which was inaugurated by Trustee Hariram Bhil. All the children were informed about Gandhiji's biography and were asked to send their friends, parents, village people to see the exhibition. Parents from all places, friends and people familiar with the institution, teachers from madrasas, etc. came every day to visit the exhibition and people from Khetasarai police station also came and saw Gandhiji's picture exhibition and noted whatever they thought necessary. Volunteer youth were asked to make notes from the exhibition by writing about Gandhiji's biography.

Peace Harmony March - From Nagar Palika Parishad Ground to Polytechnic Square in Jaunpur at 6 pm beginning from 03 November 2023 to 5 November 2023, a three-day residential workshop was held at Sahu Dharamshala Jaunpur with 25 youth from Machhli Shahar and Khetasarai in which the trainer Gautam from Jharkhand trained the youth till 5 pm, after that at 6 pm, Azad Shiksha Kendra Jaunpur, an institution for peace and harmony march, started a cultural walk from the statue of Chandrashekhar Azad in the Nagar Palika Parishad ground through Charsu Chauraha Shahipur, and the youth proceeded singing songs while playing the Dhapli.



On the second day, on 4 November, at 6 pm, the joint heritage march went from Sabzi Mandi, Shaheed Azam Sardar Bhagat Singh's statue through Atala Masjid to Manik Chowk, Raja Saheb's gate to Rameshwar Shishu Vihar, in which the youth raised slogans by lighting candles on the statue of Bhagat Singh, proceeded singing songs with the Dhapli, and after having dinner, everyone returned to Sahu Dharamshala. The youth who had come from Machhli Shahar and Khetasarai, extended their gratitude to Azad Shiksha Kendra.

Meeting of Key Persons- On 23.12.2023, a meeting was held with 8 members of the Key Person at Azad Shiksha Kendra, Rameshwar Takiya Mohalla Khetasarai, in which the previous meeting was



discussed, discussion on the Bal Mela program on 18th February, the survey of Maktab/Madrassa and Fellowship Program, discussion on when the village level meeting on social harmony should be held, discussion on when the village level meeting on social harmony should be held and 28,29,30 December was fixed. In the Bal Mela, volunteers of Azad Shiksha Kendra will perform drama on social harmony, sports program will be held as it used to be earlier.



jacket distribution program- It was decided that jacket distribution program and a meeting will be held On 28.12.2023, in which Jyotika Srivastava discussed equality and inclusion with 24 youth in attendance, and information was given about individual social and collective identity and various schemes and benefits by the government and told the youth that in this severe cold, keeping in mind all the needy people, the organization thought of giving you jackets to save you from the cold and today you people received it and wore it, there was smile and joy on everyone's face, after that Sufiyan Ahmed made everyone wear jackets, everyone thanked the organization after wearing the jacket. In the end, the meeting and jacket distribution program was concluded by giving refreshments to everyone.



National Youth Day- Dated 12.01.2024 On the occasion of National Youth Day, a meeting was organized with the youth on the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra in Takiya Mohalla Khetasarai. The meeting started with a song. After

this, Jyotika ji threw light on the life introduction of Swami Vivekananda ji and told that on the occasion of his birthday, Youth Day is celebrated with great joy in all schools and institutions. Swami ji's slogan is get up, wake up, and do not stop until the destination is achieved, the goal will not be achieved until you have faith in yourself. While discussing religion, Nisar Ahmed Khan said about all religions, how the festivals celebrated in all religions are celebrated and what is their culture, it was discussed in detail. Thereafter, while throwing light on the life of Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru, he said that Children's Day is celebrated on 14 November, Manag Tal Manechha, where the people of Nagar Panchayat and village are damaging the environment by throwing garbage, an action plan was made to stop it. So that our Nagar Panchayat remains clean and the environment is not harmed, on January 30, all of us will take out a rally on the environment and go there and make people aware not to litter here. The meeting was concluded by giving refreshments to all the children.



Aao Khel Khele Program- On 28.01.2024, Sufiyan Ahmed, Jyotika Srivastava, Beenu organized the Aao Khel Khele program with the children of Gurani SC Colony and Bhudkudha Mushar Colony in the field of Gurani village, in which boys and girls participated. Rope jumping, chair race, rig throw, kabaddi, kho-kho etc. were played in the games. Children participated with great enthusiasm in all the games. During the game, parents and spectators of the BDC children of the village were also present. Everyone enjoyed the game and the parents also kept an eye with their responsibility so that no other partner could be there. After the game was over, all the

participants were given prizes. The prize distribution was done by the respected persons, elders, women and parents of the village and finally the program was concluded by giving refreshments to the children.

Today on 30.01.2024, on Gandhiji's martyrdom day, a rally was taken out by the children of Genius Center Sondhi and the companions and volunteers of Azad Shiksha Kendra. The rally passed through Nagar Panchayat Khetasarai and ended at Manag Tal. Mainly there was a discussion about the dirt here. The youth cleaned up and the children presented poems, songs and speeches. The children were given prizes and certificates. After this, the children were made to take a pledge to have humanity instead of brutality, love instead of hatred, non-violence instead of violence, uniting instead of dividing, friendship instead of quarrel and truth instead of lies. After this, the program was concluded by giving refreshments.

Today on 04.02.2024, on the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra, a food cooking program was organized with the youth in Sarai Yusuf Machhlisahr Jaunpur. The meeting started with introductions. All the youth cooked food and helped by sharing their favorite work. After this, a discussion was held on Ram Mandir, whether it is right or wrong to build Ram Mandir. If it is right or wrong, then why? The youth said that if a school had been built instead of the temple, then children of all castes and religions would have received education and if a hospital had been built, then everyone would have got free medicine and treatment and people of all castes and religions come there but only people of one religion go to the temple. After this, Prabha ji said that what are the things that unite and break the society. The



children expressed their views on this. After this, Prabha ji explained in detail what things unite and what break and some things are our need, like hospital, this is our need but we need movement. It unites and some festivals unite and some break like Holi, Khichdi it breaks, after the discussion everyone had food and the meeting ended.



Women's meeting- On date-13.02.2024, on the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra, first of all women were introduced in Takiya Mohalla Khetasarai, after this a song was presented, then women were told about the importance of women's group, today women need to develop the habit of saving, the government is also paying a lot of attention to the women's group, the interaction of women is increasing through women's group. They are getting involved in each other's happiness and sorrow and do not have to depend on others for money. After this, there was a discussion about discrimination between boys and girls. Understanding was made by talking specially about the discrimination on food, clothing, health, education, etc. After this, all the women were asked to come to the program of Bal Mela to be organized as a symbol of social harmony in Shahi Talab Furkaniya School on 18 February. Finally, the meeting was concluded by serving refreshments.

Bal Mela - on 18 February 2024 Azad Shiksha Kendra Ras Mandal Sadar Jaunpur has been organizing Samajik Harmony Bal Mela for the last 14 years, in which people of all religions, youth, children, men, women, Maktab / Madrasa, primary school children are participating. And in Bal Mela, everyone participates in each other's happiness and sorrow and lives together.

First of all, in Bal Mela, the participants were given breakfast along with registration. To remove social irony, the games played by boys were played by girls and the work and games of girls were played by boys, due to this the message went in the society that any game and work can be played and done by everyone. So that girls get equal opportunities along with boys, the main games played by girls are- kite flying, slow cycle race, chair race, jalebi race, games played by boys- button stitching, painting competition, etc. A play was staged by the children to make girls self-reliant in which the children showed

through the play that boys go out to study and not girls, but daughters should also be sent out to study. Sons and daughters should be given equal opportunities and there should be no discrimination. At the end of the program, various speakers said that in this Bal Mela, different cultures and



civilizations meet, in this Bal Mela, the bigotry of caste and religion ends, this creates brotherhood and social harmony in the society. After the views of the speakers, the children who participated in the sports competition were honored by giving prizes. In the end, the program was concluded by Nisar Ahmed Khan by expressing gratitude to all the people who came to the Bal Mela.



Meeting with women- On 11.03.2024, on the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra, a meeting was held with women in Netanagar Machhlisahr Jaunpur.

Gender work was discussed in the meeting. The meeting started with a group song. After this, what are men and women doing throughout the



day? During the discussion, it came out that women do four times more work than men. Men work outside and women work at home. Men get money and goods in return for work, whereas women neither get money nor respect. You people should respect your own work, only then you will get respect. Family and society decide that where money is available, men will work and where money is not available, women will work. Hence, you people should take responsibility towards social gender discrimination and make the family and society aware.

International Women's Day - Women's Day was celebrated with women in the Panchayat Bhawan of Said gorari on 10 March 2024. Due to Holi festival on 8 March, 10 March was celebrated on the occasion of Savitribai Phule's Parinirman Diwas. Women expressed happiness that earlier women did not have the right to vote, women also got less wages, women raised their voice against oppression, took out rallies, conferences were held and finally got success, since then Women's Day started being celebrated all over the world on 8 March. Deepa said that all of us women should become self-reliant and educated, education is the milk of a lioness, whoever drinks it will roar. Archana, we women should be educated so that no one can mislead us and women can walk with their heads held high in the society. Jyotika has informed that the woman who was the leader of the Democratic Party first proposed that on 19 March, it was celebrated on 23 February in Russia and on 8 March in

India. All the countries decided that 8 March would be celebrated as International Women's Day in the entire country. In between, the women also sang songs. Brijesh Ji told the women to do organic farming so that people's health remains good.

Nisaar Ahmed said that you people told through the song that how much the women were harassed. We got two days after a lot of struggles. Women's Day, Labour Day, all are labourers, whether they are making something in the company or writing or studying in the office, there should be no discrimination against anyone, further it was said that work for yourself for 28 days but work for the society for 2 days. After this type of discussion, the women celebrated Women's Day by singing songs and dances and in the end the programme was concluded by serving refreshments.

Today on 20.03.2024, on the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra, Savitribai Phule's birthday was celebrated with the women in village Majhaura Khetasarai Jaunpur. Women from many villages participated in this program.

First of all, all the women were introduced. Anju and Sarita welcomed everyone by garlanding the photo of Savitribai Phule and a group song was sung by the women. Binu ji, while throwing



light on the life of Savitribai Phule, said that she established a girls' school for women and faced many difficulties to educate the women and Dalit castes and worked to eradicate the evil practices prevalent in the society. Jyotiba Phule, Usman Sheikh and his sister Fatima Sheikh also cooperated with her. Birthdays should be celebrated by remembering such great heroes. This is our shared heritage that you people from different villages came together and celebrated the birthday by

arranging food and drinks. All the people present ate together and served food, thereafter the programme was concluded.

On 20.03.2024, with the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra, a youth meeting was organized in Takiya Mohalla Khetasarai. The meeting started with the introduction. The youth present said their name, introduction, address, since when they are associated with Azad Shiksha



Kendra. All the youth said that a group song was sung by the children. After this, Binu ji discussed in detail the concept of shared heritage and told that just like shared heritage festivals, fairs, songs, music etc., similarly, Azad Shiksha Kendra has been organizing Bal Mela for many years. People of all castes and religions (women, men, and children) etc. come to this Bal Mela. It is our shared heritage. There is no discrimination of any kind in this Bal Mela. Mutual harmony is seen among the children. You people have to take the responsibility of the arrangements in the Bal Mela so that the Bal Mela is memorable this year as well like every year. The action plan of the Bal Mela was made by everyone and the meeting was concluded.

Holi Milan program- On 20.03.2024, with the initiative of Azad Shiksha Kendra, a Holi Milan program was organized in Takiya Mohalla Khetasarai with the women and youth of the project area. The program was started by Geetanjali and Mahek singing the welcome song. After this, the women present sang songs and Holi songs. The women also danced. After this, Beenu discussed the importance of Holi and said that colors have some relationships which promote brotherhood among each other. In the festival, people forget their old grievances and start anew. The festival is celebrated as

the victory of faith and belief over ego. The festival ends negative things and brings positive thinking in people. After this, all the women played Holi with flowers in the Holi Milan program which is being organized by Azad Shiksha Kendra for the last many years. People of all religions and castes play Holi with flowers and no one objects to it. In the end, everyone had lunch after singing Phaguwa and the program was concluded.

10. The Azad Shiksha Kendra introduced social responsibility, Constitutional rights and different types of role experiences among the youth.

- (e) Social integrity and equality will have been promoted for all community and groups without any discrimination.
- (a) Identification of dropped out school going children
- (b) Accessibility of Government Facility will be insured for needed person like Education, Health and Environment.

- (c) Tricycle distribution to special need people women and men for which they can move anywhere without any help of others person and can start some income generated activities for their livelihood.
- (d) Future planning of the organization is to train on constitutional rights of the people basically labours law and registration.
- (e) Youth promoting about their future planning education and training. Vocational training program, skill development and jobs availabilities.
- (f) Girls' youth training program, vocational training, sewing, embroidery, dardozi etc for livelihood.
- (g) Women livelihood program at varies skill developments as carpet weaning, sewing, embroidery, dardozi etc
